A stroll down nearby Fifth Avenue will stop you in your tracks at the stunning window displays at shops like Tiffany & Co. and Bergdorf Goodman. Get into the spirit of the season at the Radio City Christmas Spectacular, a joy for kids of all ages - and tour the legendary Music Hall too! Marvel at New York's skyline as you cruise on the Hudson River while enjoying lunch, and dine at the unforgettable Sammy's. There truly is no better time to enjoy New York City than during the Holidays, and no better way to see it than with TRIPS!

Itinerary

December 13, 2026 - Welcome to New York and Times Square!

You depart for **New York** this morning, where on arrival you'll be met and assisted with your transfer to your hotel, the **M Social** in the heart of the theater district at **52nd and Broadway**! This is the perfect home base, with enthralling views of **Times Square** from the terrace bar! This evening is yours free to relax and unwind, with dinner on your own and so many great dining choices waiting just outside your door! Overnight: M Social Times Square

December 14, 2026 ~ New York Sightseeing!

After breakfast on your own, visit the **9/11 Memorial Museum** honoring the memory of those killed. This self-guided tour includes the films "Facing Crisis: America Under Attack" and "Facing Crisis: A Changed World." Paying reverent homage to the nearly 3,000 victims of the attacks, the museum also recognizes the thousands who survived, and all who showed extraordinary courage and compassion in the catastrophe's aftermath. There is time for you to visit the adjacent **9/11 Memorial Plaza** as well. The Memorial features two enormous waterfalls and reflecting pools, each about an acre in size, set within the footprints of the original Twin Towers. The names of every person who died in the attacks are inscribed into bronze panels edging the Memorial pools, a powerful reminder to us all. (For those who've previously visited the 9/11 Memorial, at a later date you might be offered an alternate option to experience the sweeping views from the "Top of the Rock" instead, but it will depend on both availability and touring logistics as the time gets nearer; we'll inform you closer to the tour date if this option does become viable.) This afternoon features a lunch cruise aboard Bateaux New York's unique European-inspired, glass enclosed dining vessel. Bateaux offers you a sophisticated way to sightsee while enjoying a three-course plated lunch. Imagine seeing the Statue of Liberty, the Brooklyn Bridge and One World Trade Center while dining and listening to tunes from the accompanying pianist. You'll cruise on the Hudson and East Rivers while hearing a bit about the area. Most guests choose dressy-casual attire for this special lunch. Then you're off on a sightseeing tour - anointed as the unofficial "capital of the world," New York City is undoubtedly one of the greatest and most interesting cities you'll ever visit. From world-famous Central Park to Museum Mile, you'll learn all about the Big Apple and why we love to visit. This evening, turn back the clock to a fondly remembered era when you dine at Sammy's! From "My Fair Lady" to "Aladdin" and "The Phantom of the Opera," the list of iconic Broadway shows that debuted on the Great White Way continues to grow. Nearer to departure, you'll be able to make a choice from several shows being offered. This evening, enjoy dinner on your own at one of the restaurants, delis or cafes in the area.
