You'll go with us to coffee plantations and visit a sustainable farm. The country's colorful cast of living creatures, ranging from howler monkeys to toucans, are abundant everywhere and so easy to spot! You'll definitely find more than enough to do and see while touring around this remarkable country!

Itinerary

February 6, 2026 - Your Journey Begins!

You'll board your international flight today bound for **Costa Rica**! On arrival you'll be assisted with your transfer to your San José hotel, then enjoy your **Welcome to Costa Rica Dinner** at the hotel this evening! Overnight: San José - DoubleTree by Hilton (D)

February 7, 2026 - Coffee Plantation and Archeological Site

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel prior to checking out and departing to explore the **Doka Coffee Plantation**, a major coffee producer sitting at an altitude of 4,500 feet. The volcanic soil, crisp clean mountain air and abundant sunshine combine to create the perfect conditions to produce the **finest Arabica coffee**. You'll enjoy your included lunch here before heading out to **Sarapiquí**, an exciting new location for ecotourism at the edge of the **Braulio Carrillo National Park**. **Costa Rican native wildlife** is abundant along this biological corridor, with many exotic species of birds, mammals, amphibians and reptiles. You'll visit a Sarapiquí hotel that was built on an old orange plantation, and when construction began they found an indigenous cemetery. So they created an **archeological site** as part of the hotel's gardens, to preserve, honor and study this burial site that you'll tour. You'll then check in at your nearby resort hotel and enjoy tonight's dinner.

Overnight: Sarapiqui - El Lugar Resort Hotel (or similar) (B/L/D)

<u>February 8, 2026 - Sarapiqui River Cruise and Chocolate Tour</u>
After your hotel breakfast, you'll depart for a leisurely **pontoon boat cruise on the Sarapiqui River**, exploring the river's vibrant ecosystem

that runs through a variety of environments - tropical wet forests, mountains, pastures, and more. Be on the lookout for wildlife in the water and on land, as you may be able to see monkeys, iguanas, sloths, crocodiles, alligators, otters, and a variety of bird species. Your guides will help you spot animals, explaining the ecological significance of the area, and you'll enjoy lunch afterward at a local restaurant. Then you'll be treated to a tasty tour where you'll get to know the wonders of one of mankind's favorite foods: chocolate! This plant is native to Central America, and was important to both the Mayan and Aztec cultures. You'll start by crossing the suspension bridge to a former cacao-growing plot. As you walk, the natural and cultural history of the cacao tree will be explained. On arrival at the plot, the artisanal process by which cacao fruit is transformed into chocolate will be shown (harvest, fermentation, drying, etc.), as the story of preand post-colonial chocolate is told. While at the site, you may taste different kinds of chocolate, prepared on the spot in a traditional method. You'll return back to your hotel this evening and enjoy your dinner at the hotel.

Overnight: Sarapiqui - El Lugar Resort Hotel (or similar) (B/L/D)

February 9, 2026 - Don Juan Farm and Thermal Hot Springs
After breakfast at the hotel, you'll travel to the Arenal volcano region
and visit the Don Juan Educational Farm, with your lunch included.
Run by a former school teacher, this farm is a community project to
promote sustainable farming practices. On only five acres of land, cattle
graze and over 30 different crops are raised. You can have an interactive
experience planting and collecting crops, and learn about sugar cane

milling, plus participate in cooking and preparing organically produced treats! This afternoon, you'll check in to your hotel where you can relax and revitalize in their pools fed from the crystalline hot springs of the imposing Arenal Volcano, surrounded by the beautiful and exotic tropical vegetation of Costa Rica. The four pools vary in temperature from 93 to 104 degrees, and were created to let you experience a natural thermal river right in the middle of the rainforest. Enjoy dinner this evening at the hotel, and the delightful springs throughout your two-night stay! Overnight: Arenal Springs Resort

February 10, 2026 - Arenal Sky Adventure + Optional Zip Lining This morning after breakfast, you'll head out to Sky Adventure for a scenic tram tour and optional zip line experience. The tram gondolas rise smoothly through the rain forest, offering endless views on their mountainous ascent. Your guide will point out characteristics of the flora and fauna and other intriguing facets of the Arenal rainforest area. You'll then reach a wide observation platform on the highest point of the reserve, where you can enjoy the breathtaking views of the Arenal Volcano and Lake, and the surrounding forests. You'll then take the tram back down the mountain, or you may prefer to get back to the base riding down thrilling ziplines! There are 7 cables going up to 656 ft. in height and 2460 ft. in length, and you'll be astounded by the impressive heights, speeds up to 43.5 mph, and spectacular views that'll leave you in awe of the surrounding mountains! After enjoying a leisurely lunch at a local restaurant, you'll return to your resort surrounded by tropical gardens and outstanding views of Arenal Volcano. Relax and enjoy your free late afternoon here, perhaps taking advantage of the resort's spa services, or their soothing hot springs pools available to guests, or maybe even a bit of horseback riding on the property. Your dinner tonight will be at a local restaurant.

Overnight: Arenal Springs Resort

February 11, 2026 - Sarchí Artisan Center to San José

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel prior to checking out and departing Arenal to travel back to the **San José** area. En route, you'll enjoy an intriguing tour of the renowned Sarchí Artisan Center. The town of Sarchi is a major crafts center in Costa Rica, where the arts and crafts are boldly hand painted. At your painting class with a local artist, you can even try your own hand here at painting an oxcart wheel, the national symbol of Costa Rica! Since oxcarts have long been a vital means to transport coffee beans to the central Pacific port, the artisans of Sarchi have paid tribute to their importance in perfecting this unique art of creating vividly colored wheels. You'll enjoy lunch in this charming village, then have an opportunity to explore the dozens of shops. Later this afternoon, you'll depart for your hotel with time to freshen up before enjoying your included Farewell Dinner!
