January 26, 2027 - Eden



Breathtaking in any weather, the fjords' cliffs rise vertically from the dark waters, mountain peaks scrape the sky and waterfalls cascade. **Doubtful Sound** is the second longest in New Zealand and the country's second most famous attraction. On this day at sea you'll enjoy all three of these majestic areas of the **Fjordlands National Park** from the comfort of your stateroom. (B/L/D)

February 1, 2027 - Dunedin (Port Chalmers)

You're docked today at **Dunedin** from **9am to 6pm**. This dramatic South Island coastal town offers both unique natural beauty and fascinating history. **Rare yellow-eyed penguins, fur seals and the Royal Albatross** all call Dunedin home.
