October 25, 2024 - Your Adventure Begins! Today you'll board your international overnight flight to Spain!

October 26, 2024 - Barcelona, Spain

On arrival, you'll be met by your TRIPS representative and embark on your panoramic city tour of Barcelona, a true cosmopolitan masterpiece! With a history rich in art and architecture, medieval, Gothic, and modern influences can be seen all over this alluring city. From the shady, tree-lined Las Ramblas Boulevard to the Museu Picasso and Fundació Joan Miró museums to the sandy beaches near the harbor, there's no end to the riches of Barcelona. And you simply can't miss the uniquely whimsical architecture of Antoni Gaudi dotted all around the city, most whimsically at the fanciful hilltop Parc Guell. Afterward, you'll be assisted with check-in to your hotel, where you can relax and enjoy the evening with dinner on your own. Overnight: Barcelona

October 27, 2024 - Come Sail Away from Barcelona!

After your hotel checkout, you'll embark on a tour of the jaw-dropping Sagrada Familia Cathedral, Gaudi's bizarrely intricate monumental work that's still in progress after over a century! You'll then transfer to the boutique Azamara Onward in time for a late lunch and unpacking for your 10 luxurious nights, before sailing away at 6pm this evening.

. October 28, 2024 - Valencia, Spain

From 7:30am to 10pm today, you're docked at Valencia, Spain's thirdlargest city and one that's a very pleasant surprise to many. Home to the signature Spanish dish paella as well as the sacred Holy Grail, it's also blessed with ideal Mediterranean weather. A top Valencia attraction is its popular City of Arts and Sciences, with futuristic structures including a planetarium, oceanarium and interactive museum. Not surprisingly, Valencia has several fine beaches too, including some in nearby Albufera **Park**, a wetlands reserve with a lovely lake and walking trails.

October 29, 2024 - Cartagena, Spain

Cartagena, a historic Mediterranean seaport tracing back to the Roman Empire that was once the seat of ancient Carthage, also boasts the

picturesque Paseo Alfonso XII manicured promenade lined with palm trees, taking you to marvelous ancient ruins still surviving between modern-day buildings. The Naval Museum reveals much about this "City of Cultures," where you can explore everything from the Roman ruins at the Museum of the Roman Theatre right up to modern designs inspired by Gaudi. You'll also find delicious dining options in any direction. The Onward is docked here from 11am to 6pm. (B/L/D)

October 30, 2024 ~ Málaga, Spain: Gateway to Granada

Today finds you in Málaga from 7:30am to 10pm, the birthplace of Pablo Picasso, and in itself a beautiful work of art. You'll find the Museo Picasso, dedicated to his life and work, a must-visit museum for art lovers. Another wonderful place to see is the Alcazaba, a 11thcentury citadel that's home to three palaces, beautiful gardens, and opulent fountains. From Málaga, many choose to travel out to Granada with its intriguing mix of Arab and European cultures. Cradled by the lush Sierra Nevada mountains, Granada's historic buildings astound with their intricate carvings and minute ornamentation. The must-see Nasrid Palaces Complex is home to the famed Alhambra with its brilliantly decorated walls, ceilings and floors. Perched on a high plateau above the city, this imposing UNESCO World Heritage site was the last Moorish stronghold in Europe, offering superb architecture, breathtaking views, and the spectacular cascading water features of its lush Generalife Gardens. Also notable is the Spanish Renaissance-style Granada Cathedral, built by order of Queen Isabella on the exact site of the of the recently vanquished Moors' mosque.

October 31, 2024 - Gibraltar, United Kingdom

You'll see just how impressive a rock can be when first viewing the **Rock** of Gibraltar, towering above the countryside! Ceded in perpetuity to Great Britain by Spain in 1713, for thousands of years 'The Rock' has been a beacon signaling its crucial position at the Strait between the Mediterranean Sea and Atlantic Ocean. Aficionados of military history must tour the Great Siege Battlefield. The Upper Rock military installation and nature reserve is where you'll find the famous Barbary **Macaques monkeys**, the only wild monkey population on the European continent. And don't miss Main Street with many shopkeepers dating

back centuries, and some of the best Mediterranean value shopping in this **VAT-free** territory! You'll dock here from **8am** to **8pm**. (B/L/D)

November 1, 2 & 3, 2024 - Three Days in Seville, Spain

Perhaps the chief highlight of your itinerary will be the three glorious days you'll enjoy in Spain's most beloved city, Seville, where you'll dock from 1pm on the 1st through 2pm on the 3rd. Seville is credited with the **invention of tapas**, and you could join the locals as they graze from bar to bar, making an entire meal out of the journey. Long before tapas, the legend of **Don Juan** was also born here, along with numerous Seville-set operas ranging from "Carmen" to "Don Giovanni," "The Marriage of Figaro" and of course, "The Barber of Seville!" Seville is especially known for its picturesque public plazas that are typically surrounded by private homes and overflowing with colorful flowers. The top attractions in the city include the famous Jewish quarter of Santa Cruz, a labyrinth of narrow streets leading to the gorgeous Plaza de los Venerables. You might also explore the exquisitely ornate Alcázar castle complex built during the Moorish Almohad dynasty, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and perhaps the finest remaining example of Mudéjar architecture, featuring lovely themed gardens laid out in terraces. Seville Cathedral, the world's largest gothic cathedral famously housing the **Tomb of Columbus**, is another must-see, that also includes the Giralda bell tower, originally built as a Moorish minaret. The Plaza de España was built as the centerpiece of the 1929 Ibero-American Exposition. Another delightful place to visit is Seville's bustling gourmet market Mercado Lonja del Barranco. And the Quarter of Triana, the intriguing old sailors' and potters' neighborhood, is particularly atmospheric. Other great Seville landmarks are the University, the Old Tobacco Factory, San Telmo Palace, the Golden Tower,

Isabel II Bridge and the Basilica Macarena.

November 4, 2024 - At Sea on the Onward

Enjoy a relaxing sea day on board the Onward where it's now the perfect time to experience all that your **boutique hotel at sea** has to offer - or simply do nothing at all! From **decadent specialty dining**, to **immersive lectures**, to **tranquil spa treatments**, the choice is yours for this indulgent day of pure relaxation.
